Minutes of Meeting

March 4, 2026

The Menominee County Buildings & Grounds Committee met on March 4, 2026 at 12:00 PM at the Menominee County Courthouse in Menominee, Michigan.

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair Johnson at 12:05 PM.

II. Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

III. Roll Call

Present: Johnson, Phelps, Mekash, Philipps, Betzinger, & Rye.

Absent: None.

IV. Approval of the Agenda

Motion made by Betzinger, seconded by Philipps to approve the agenda. Vote taken.
MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

V. Approval of Previous Minutes (February 19, 2025 & October 14, 2025)

Motion made by Phelps, seconded by Mekash to approve the previous meeting minutes from February 19, 2025 & October 14, 2025. Vote taken. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

VII. Business

A. Bid Review – Project # FY2026-01 – Menominee County

One proposal was received for Project # FY2026-01, Menominee County Exterior Renovation Project from Klema Painting & Decorating, Inc. in the amount of \$284,400.

Administrator Carviou stated that two contractors came to look at the project. This project was the most advertised project since his time as County Administrator, being published in the Green Bay, Appleton, Iron Mountain, & Escanaba newspapers, Menominee County Journal, Lufts Advertiser, Iron Mountain/Norway Builders Exchange, Marquette Builders Exchange, Builders Exchange of Wisconsin, county website, and on social media.

The Committee discussed the description of work and what was all being included in this project. If selected, Klema will want to meet the Committee to approve the paint colors and schemes. The proposal includes a price guarantee; however, additional expenses could be incurred if the County submits a change order or if there are more extensive carpentry repairs than anticipated. There is \$350,000 budgeted for this project.

Administrator Carviou stated that it is his understanding that the City of Menominee Historic District Commission will need to approve the final paint color as well. The project would start as soon as weather permits – starting with masonry – and finish up by September 30, 2026 – per the proposal.

Motion made by Phelps, seconded by Philipps to recommend to the Menominee County Board of Commissioners that the proposal submitted by Klema Painting & Decorating in the amount of \$284,400 for Project # FY2026-01, Menominee County Courthouse Exterior Renovation Project be approved. Vote taken. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

B. Quotes - Skid Steer & Implements

The Committee discussed the different equipment needs in the different departments. Administrator Carviou advised that the Park's Department tractor needs to be replaced – his plan was to move the Kubota from the Buildings & Grounds Department to the Parks Department and leave the New Holland at the Menominee Regional Airport.

Jim Mekash & Tony Williams from the Buildings & Grounds Department stated they believe the best piece of equipment for the courthouse complex would be a small sub-compact tractor – similar in size to what they currently have. The Kubota is too big for the courthouse complex. The right tractor needs to be small enough to fit on the sidewalks and the snowblower needs to be smaller so it doesn't tear up as much grass on the sides of the sidewalks. With the type of tractor they are looking at, a broom could be added as well. Price range \$20,000 - \$30,000. In their opinion, the skid steer would be too big for the operation at the courthouse.

The Committee discussed the skid steer and the other uses throughout the county, including mulching at the airport and in the parks, fixing park roads, and just the overall versatility that the machine could be used for. Some money could be saved by not purchasing the snow removal implements and purchase the smaller tractor for the courthouse – it was discussed that buying both pieces of equipment could probably be done within or close to the original budget of \$150,000.

Tony led the effort to gather quotes for skid steers from local dealers. The Committee discussed the pros & cons of the different makes in-depth. The Committee asked Tony

which one he liked the most, as he was the most experienced and would be the primary operator. Tony stated he preferred the Kubota, but has not actually been in any of these machines.

All the machines are within the same price range – and the same specs. There was discussion about service, parts, and ability to train others on the machines. The Committee wants Tony to go and test the Kubota & the New Holland. At this time, the Committee wants to focus on purchasing the machine with the bucket & forks – other implements can wait for the next meeting.

The Committee want to make a recommendation for the County Board meeting on March 10, 2026. The consensus was to recommend the Kubota from Beaver Machine at \$74,991 and the New Holland from Linsmeier Implement at \$80,899 with the final decision being made by the Buildings & Grounds Department after they go and test the machines.

Motion made by Philipps, seconded by Rye to recommend to the Menominee County Board of Commissioners to approve the purchase of a: A) Kubota SVL 75-3 skid steer in the amount of \$74,991 from Beaver Machine; OR B) New Holland C337 skid steer in the amount of \$80,899 from Linsmeier Implement; the final decision of what machine to purchase will be made by the Buildings & Grounds Department. Vote taken. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

C. Quotes – Dump Trailer

Administrator Carviou gather quotes from as many local dealers as he could find for a dump trailer for the Parks Department. He called each dealer, told them what they were looking for and that they wanted to haul a skid steer in it, and what their best price was.

The Committee discussed the different trailer specs – all were pretty similar.

Administrator Carviou said from the additional research he has done and from reviews – the Iron Bull or PJ appear to be the better trailers. The MAXX-D trailers are probably the best, but they are intended for heavy-duty and construction applications – explaining the higher price tag. He recommends the PJ trailer from Mirsberger – that is where the County purchased the equipment trailer from several years ago and is the same brand, so we have some knowledge of the quality of this brand. The \$500 price different between the PJ and Iron Bull becomes close to a moot point when you factor in the price of picking it up – about 40 minutes closer to Hilbert compared to Wausau.

Total budget is \$12,000 – with \$6,000 received from a Hannahville 2% Grant.

Motion made by Phelps, seconded by Betzinger to recommend to the Menominee County Board of Commissioners to approve the purchase of a dump trailer from Mirsberger in the amount of \$10,995.00. Vote taken. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

C. Other Business

The storage building at the Courthouse Complex is complete. Anyone that would like to see it after the meeting is welcome.

Phelps asked about a few projects at the library in Stephenson. The roof leak was fixed – it had to do with one of the drains, but wasn't because of the work related to the new roof that was put on. It was requested that Buildings & Grounds put together some estimates to replace the metal on the outside of the library building, replace the existing vinyl siding with LP, and to build a covered entrance into the building for the next Buildings & Grounds Committee.
