WHEREAS, the telecommunicator response to calls for help gives the citizens of Menominee County a quick response to emergency calls for law enforcement, fire, or emergency medical services; and


WHEREAS, the telecommunicator serves as the first, first responder and the voice of reason, providing direction and comfort for those in crisis to rely on when they call 911; and
