Dear Mr. Bousley:

In reference to your 1July2011 letter to Kenneth Goffin, Supervisor of Menominee Township, we are submitting the following to comply with the requirements to qualify for disbursement of three-way road program funding:

a . Detailed explanation of project was in general, it was three separate road projects that were submitted to the adhoc committee not knowing exactly how much each would cost or what amount of funds was available. Blacktopping of section of #9 Road; Double chip sealing a section of #7 Road and roadwork on 6.5 lane. Our project will be limited to the work on #9 road: Road Blacktop, 7/10 mile Western end of #9 Road of hot mix completed by Bacco Construction: Contracted cost \$59,960.00.

b. Enclosed is the required \$5253.75; our "surety" for our township portion of the total expected \$48, 939.09 amount to "Menominee County" as our contribution to the three-way road program. It is our understanding that we will be responsible for the remaining balance over the total amount disbursed to us, which would be an additional \$11,010.91 that the township would pay to Bacco for this road project.

If the county treasurer has a problem accepting this check then reissuing money, may I recommend that township checks be held and returned to township upon disbursement of the county funds. It is my understanding County Operating fund checks and County Road Commission checks would be issued separately anyway.

Thank you for your support of the three way road program. It most certainly will help since we have several roads in our scope to repair and is our townships priority issue.


Dear Sirs;



The City of Menominee appreciates the invitation from the Menominee County Board of Commissioners to participate in the Three Way Road Program. We have read and understand the proposal and would like this letter to be considered as our application for the City of Menominee's portion of the program funding.

It is our interpretation of the program description that our portion of the county funding (\$10,495.90) will be combined with the city match (\$2,623.98) for a total of \$13,119.88 of project funds. It is our understanding that these funds can be used for any roadway improvement within the right of way of the community. Given that our grant award and project total is \$13,119.88 we believe the best and highest use for these funds would be to repair and/or replace wheelchair ramps at intersections that lead to the elementary, intermediate, junior and senior high schools. Through a this grant opportunity, we will be able to address traffic safety, pedestrian access and Americans with Disabilities Act issues around the schools, while also acknowledging the health benefits of active school travel.

Once awarded the funding for this program we will request proposals from construction firms to remove and replace these travel corridors with new ADA compatible and compliance structures. We anticipate that the evaluation and proposal process will take between two to four weeks to complete. Following the proposal evaluation we will award a contract and advise the Menominee County Board of the proposed ramp locations. We are expecting to have all funded ramps installed by October 1, 2011.
