



Review/Approve Agenda: Mark Erickson made the motion to approve the agenda with support from Brian Bousley. Motion passed.

Review/Approve Minutes of last meeting: Mark Erickson made a motion to approve the minutes from April 14, 2016 with support from Mark Petersen. Motion passed.

Public Comment: None

Presentations: FBI Video "The Coming Storm." Active Shooter/Hostile event response training. Immediate call to outside resources. Unified command. This was a well-run, prepared operation, unfortunately it won't always be this way. Communication is first and foremost the most important element in a successful response. 45% incidences occur in commercial areas, 25% of those in educational buildings.

Mike Schaffer commented that these incidences can occur anywhere, it is the responsibility of each business owner/ manager to be prepared.

Nearest FBI office is in Marquette, MI

With the limited resources Menominee County has, the county still needs to be prepared to handle the event on its own until mutual aid and other outside resources can be relocated to assist in the recovery operations
