





6. Presentation: Canadian National Railroad could not attend but would like to present at next meeting
7. Old Business
  - a. Menominee County hazard mitigation plan: CUPPAD is trying to wrap it up, has been slowed with COVID. Hoping to be ready by the end of August.
  - b. MABAS: E911 Center acts as division 3801 dispatch center when MABAS is activated. They have been live since 1<sup>st</sup> of the year, have had a couple activations and are currently working on drills to get all of dispatch up to speed with it.
  - c. State wide drill April 20, 2020: This was cancelled due to COVID, hoping to run it in the spring of 2021. Members present feel a walk thru activation of the EOC should be done since it has been some time since last one. Looking to do something in the fall when things open up a little more.
  - d. Radio Communications: Consultant group was hired by the county to do a complete study of the radio system in the county. They are working on collecting data on where all responders are located, equipment they are using, trouble they are experiencing. Possibly looking at utilizing towers currently in place or putting up a new one, also looking at additional uses for towers county has now or will add if needed. Hoping to have all data gathered and a report done by the end of summer.
8. New Business
  - a. COVID issues in Menominee County : Emergency management reported on their responsibilities during the pandemic. Acquiring and distributing PPE and supplies.
