



Make a lap-size quilt from start to finish, using the latest time-saving techniques. No sewing experience is required – we'll teach you how to use a sewing machine. Your quilt will include a central "focus fabric" plus coordinating fabrics. The design is called Churn Dash.

Learn how to:

- Choose fabrics and colors to make a pleasing design.
- Use a rotary cutter and mat to cut strips of fabric.
- Sew the quilt top using the quick strip-piecing method.
- Machine-quilt or hand-tie the quilt layers together.

Sewing machines will be available, though you may bring your own if you prefer. The \$55 registration fee includes fabric, thread, batting, a morning snack and Michigan 4-H Participation fee. All quilting tools will be provided.

On Day 1 we will meet at 9 a.m. at Quilter's Haven Quilt Shop at 447 First Street, across from The Landing restaurant. There you will learn how to select your fabric – even though everyone is making the same design, each quilt will be unique because of your fabric choices. We will bring you back to Menominee Township Hall where you will get started.
