DO HEREBY FURTHER DETERMINE: That the following Proposition or Question was approved or defeated as indicated below.

Wording of Proposition	
Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Stephenson Area Public Schools District, Menominee County, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 3 years, 2019 to 2021, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, the construction or repair of, school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2019 is approximately \$250,780 annually.
