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**Approval of Agenda** - Moved by Peggy Schroud, seconded by Tom Lesperance to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

**2011 Work Progress Report:** Bill Lenca handed out progress for the 2011 grant year. In 2011, we completed a total of 82 corners. Our project was for 74, so we did a few extra corners (8) in section 41/26. There were a few corners in section 36/24 (state land, with state monuments already there) were not done but were replaced by section 41/26. The section we replaced was in the Hayward Lake and North Lake areas. It's more a question of when we can get into them to do the work.

**2012 Grant Application:** Everyone received the grant application with their agendas. This year our state funding is \$91,708. Typically our grant money is about \$53,000. Two years ago the county put \$37,000 funding into the program, because of that we get almost dollar for dollar back on that, so we're getting that back this year.

**2012 Work Areas:** This year we'll work on sections 39/25 and a few corners in 39/26. We're looking at 115 total corners.

Motion to approve the 2012 grant was moved by Tom Lesperance and seconded by Peggy Schroud. All members present approve.

**Any Other Items:** Memorandum #16 has been corrected now. Tom Lesperance: How does the public gain access to these records? Bill: Corner Records are available on line at the state of MI website. DLEG. Tom: Is it available as a shape file? If the information were available, I think developers would be interested in that info. Bill: We have the info. on auto CAD. I think it can be converted to a shape file. I could use the info. if it were assessable. Peggy: that could tie in with the MapsInDeed that we will have available to the public. Tom: How much do you do with the GPS coordinate system? Bill: Not much. Sherry: Do you set GPS coordinates? Bill: No, we set state plane Coordinates. That is not available to the public. Mark: as a land owner, this has been a great program. I think this has solved a lot of problems. Does the plat book show these corners? No. (it used to) a majority of people don't know this is going on. Bill: Most people are receptive but there have been a few to say they don't want us on their property.
