COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE PROCEEDINGS
FEBRUARY 9, 2009

A Committee-of-the-Whole meeting of the Menominee City Council, City of Menominee, County of Menominee, State of Michigan, was held Monday, February 9, 2009 at 10 a.m. in the Municipal Complex Council Chambers.

The Honorable George W. Krahn called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilmember Hudon and seconded by Councilmember Fernstrum to excuse Councilmember Sorensen from the meeting. This motion was carried unanimously.
