Regular Meeting Minutes
January 21, 2010
6:06 P.M.

Chairperson Schultz called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Erdman placed roll call- **Present:** Mike Erdman, Lillian Schultz, Cheryl Hargrove, Jason Lauzer, Rosalie Naser, and County Commissioners Gary Eichhorn and James Furlong.

Review and discussion of the relinquishing of PA 116. Commissioner Furlong made a motion to place on file, Lauzer seconded. Motion passed.

There was discussion of the revisions that need to be made on the 2003 Comprehensive Plan. Erdman will contact CUPPAD to see if they will attend our next meeting to aid the PC in the changes that need to be made.

Public Comment: Kandace Curran recommended to the PC to consider the recent rulings from the Judge to be considered for the changes in the 2008 Ordinance. She also requested the PC not be involved in the Building Code Department in the permits that are issued. Robert Desjarlais agreed with Curran that the building permits issued are sent to all Supervisors and all Assessors and do not need to be micromanaged.

Erdman passed out the 106 Filing.

Commissioner Eichhorn made a motion to adjourn at 6:50 p.m. seconded by Commissioner Furlong. Motion passed.
