Productivity will be measured through statistical analysis and goal attainment.

CSPA-09-55002. Child Support Enforcement Services. Contractor – Menominee County Prosecuting Attorney. This is a one year contract for \$54,054.00.


CSFOC-09-55001, Child Support Enforcement Services. Contractor – Menominee County Friend of the Court. This is a one year contract for \$172,335.00.

Motion to accept review of all contracts was made by Mary Bradley and supported by Peggy Bastien. Motion passed without opposition.


**PUBLIC COMMENT:** None
