

Menominee County

July 9, 2008
Minutes

The meeting was held at Shakey Lakes Park and began at 6:00 p.m.

Members Present: Mark Aubert, Vola Bleile, Judy Bright, Bill Kakuk, Jason Lauzer, Mike Lyons. Member(s) absent: Greg Furmanski. Also in attendance: Steve Wery, Parks Superintendent and former board member Tina Lesperance.

Motion to approve the agenda as presented made by Bill Kakuk, seconded by Vola Bleile. Motion carried.

Minutes of the June 11, 2008 meeting were corrected to read “The committee will meet again on July 9th...” Motion made by Bill Kakuk, seconded by Jason Lauzer to approve minutes as corrected. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Two long-time lease-site campers at Kleinke, Mickey Plautz and Sue Aubrey, made several positive comments about park conditions and the crew. They also offered suggestions for improvements to signage in the park and on the highway as well as better bathroom maintenance on busy holiday weekends.

Tina Lesperance was honored for her 18 years of service on the Parks and Recreation Committee. Steve Wery presented her with a plaque and expressed his appreciation for her dedication to the parks and the committee.

The Parks Superintendent updated the committee on the Horse Area, mentioning that the County Board did approve an exemption for 4-H to use the area without a deposit, provided conditions are maintained as required.

Steve also updated the committee on lease sites at Kleinke Park and advised that he will be working on a reservation policy for long-term leases next year and will keep it on the agenda for next month as well. He commented that Kleinke Park is doing well because of these lease-sites.

Public Comment: Ms. Plautz and Ms. Aubrey commented that the committee is doing a good job.

Motion to adjourn by Mike Lyons, seconded by Bill Kakuk at 6:26 pm. Motion carried.
