

Rich Sexton spoke on the Hazmat IQ training: Marinette Hazmat team needs 20-30 minutes to be in full gear. Chlorine response can handle some exposure in turnout gear and SCBA if Fluorine, stay away. Use 3-30 rule as a guide. Discussed evac zones and 10 second sizeup, Federal Resources website good site for information.

Any Other items of Interest:

Mass notification program expensive to maintain, who would pay for it and who would use it? Homeland Security planning committee working on obtaining a notification program for each county.
