- 6) Presentations: WE Energies Hydro, Ryan Grondin 12 dams along Menominee River, have emergency plans for each of them. Every 5 years a simulation is done to present what may happen if a dam would fail. Presentation of videos –Michagamée Reservoir is a controlled release, helps provide flood control. Sub stations may be owned by ATC. Siren warning will sound when a failure may occur. Dam structures are monitored, should last 100 years plus. Map showing dams and locations indicate the possible threats, the ones to the north are more of a concern for our area. In the event of a break, all stakeholders would be notified and would be imperative that all are prepared.
