

# Menominee County Fair Board Meeting

## Wednesday, November 8, 2006

Chairperson Larry Roetzer called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Brian Eichhorn presented to everyone a building layout the size of 100' x 240'. It displayed a show ring in the middle and animals on both sides of the ring. Questions were raised 1) can all animals be housed in the same building? 2) Sizes of spots for the animals, i.e. cage sizes, pen sizes, space between cattle, sheep? 3) Do show rings have to be specific size? 4) How high can you stack cages? 5) Requirements for animal washing areas?

Discussion was also held on campsites. How many do we need? What about vendors? Where would the campsites be? DEQ regulations on campsites?

Concerns by the fair were state regulations; DEQ regulations, wetlands area do's & don't .

The Nadeau Township members were unsure why we were so concerned with state regulations when we were a county fair. It was explained to them that most of our funding comes from the state so we must follow their guidelines.
