

Menominee County Fair Board Meeting

February 17, 2016

It would be nice to have the Antique Tractor Show again at the fair. Sandy will contact Ed Granquist regarding the possibility.

Phyllis announced that the Holiday Fall Festival will be held on November 5, 2016. She has reserved the school for that date.

Phyllis will check on the possibility of having Bingo at the Fair.

The next Fair Board meeting will be held on March 16, 2016.

Gerry Piche made a motion to adjourn, motion was seconded by Phyllis and passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:15.
